LIME AID

A lively shade of green refreshes this kitchen

KRISTINE AND JON KIES WERE CERTAIN about many of their Encinitas kitchen remodel plans. They knew they wanted to expand and modernize the space. They also knew they wanted maple cabinetry and gray, concrete-style countertops. They even knew that they wanted a cooktop separate from the oven, pot and pan drawers under the cooktop, a spice rack to the right of the cooktop, a tall drawer for cupboard items by the microwave and deep drawers for Tupperware under the microwave. What they didn't know was that they wanted the backsplash to be lime green.

"The backsplash was a big discussion," says designer Kristy Kropat. "They liked the color red, but weren't totally sure. I asked them how they wanted the space to feel and they said they really wanted it to be happy. They were quite focused on that word and that's where the green came in. It's fresher and lighter than red."

Kropat animated the bold backsplash with thicker, three-dimensional accent tiles in different,

darker shades of green. She broke through the ordinary by randomly placing these eye-catchers in groups of three throughout the kitchen. The pattern is rejiggered with five lengthier strips over the cooktop.

"I worked hard on how to incorporate those accent tiles without doing it the traditional way of a straight line with a strip going all the way around," says Kropat. "The layout was problematic because the field tiles come in 12 inches and the accent tiles are only 10 inches. We had to cut down the field tiles where the accent tiles are."

The homeowners got what they wanted: a functional, clean-lined, modern kitchen with "a little bit of funk," says Kristine. "We went out of our boundaries a little bit with the backsplash, but it makes the kitchen. It's been fun to watch the reactions of people when they come over. One of my friends actually jumped up and down, saying, 'Ooh, I love your backsplash.'"
